- 36. Krug Brut Grande Cuvée, Reims** **190.00**  
Krug Brut Grande Cuvée is the timelessly stylish signature of Krug, a breathtaking Champagne that effortlessly balances richness and freshness, power and finesse. Out of contrast, harmony – a sensational taste experience. A gleaming gold colour, an extravagantly expansive bouquet, an almost creamy texture. Then, an explosion of flavours, at once mellow and mature, crisp and clean.
- 37. Laurent-Perrier Vintage 2000/2002** **68.00**  
The nose is very elegant, blending ripe fruit aromas, such as pink grapefruit and yellow peach, with hints of chocolate and crème brûlée. The palate is pleasantly firm, with whiffs of vanilla. It opens to yellow fruit flavours and has a lingering, crisp finish that shows citrus-fruit flavours.
- 38. Laurent-Perrier Ultra Brut NV** **68.00**  
A blend of 55% Chardonnay and 45% Pinot Noir, the grapes selected for this wine have a natural acid/sugar balance, so that when fermented to complete dryness, no liqueur d'expédition is required
- 39. Bollinger Special Cuvée** **75.00**  
"Bolly" is well known for its masculine black grape cepage (70% Pinot Noir, 30% Chardonnay is the norm). A high percentage of mature wines in the blend gives this famous Grande Marque immense flavour.

- 1. Chardonnay, Finca El Picador, Central Valley - Chile**  
This wine is unoaked with a delightful fruity palate. **3.50 6.50 19.00**
- 2. Pinot Grigio Pure, Veneto - Italy**  
Zing! A delightful expressive, dry wine with refreshing apple and citrus flavours. **4.00 7.25 21.00**
- 3. Sauvignon Blanc, Le Charme, Pays du Gers - France**  
Overt bouquet with classical gooseberry pungency. Refreshing and quenching on the palate. **22.00**
- 4. Sauvignon Blanc, Paua Bay, Marlborough - New Zealand**  
An explosive array of passion fruit and gooseberry aromas combine with a smattering of crushed herbs. **5.00 9.00 27.50**
- 5. Chablis, Domaine Phillip Testut, Burgundy - France**  
A beautiful full flavoured wine, elegant and classy with a lingering finish on the palate. **34.00**
-  **6. Sancerre, Domaine Jean Thomas, Loire - France**  
One of my favourite whites, this wine has immense forward fruit flavours, delicate equilibrium and a zippy finish to boot. I often enjoy a glass when eating seafood or fish although I find it equally enjoyable as an aperitif. **39.50**
- 7. Pouilly Fuissé 'Terriors', Domaine Luquet, Burgundy - France**  
Pouilly Fuissé is a generous and rich wine, with an emerald gold colour. The nature of the soil favours harmonious development of its characteristics. **44.50**
- 8. Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay, Marlborough - New Zealand**  
Its aromatics encapsulate a broad spectrum of varietal flavours; tropical fragrances of guava and mango to ripe lime/citrus and sweet herbs. The palate also is juicy and voluminous, combining concentrated flavours with a mineral acidity that leaves a long, fresh, intense finish. **49.00**

9.	<b>Chablis Grand Cru Grenouille 2008, Domaine Testut, Burgundy France</b> Generous, with soft tones and a broad palate. Not overly complex but good.	<b>82.50</b>
10.	<b>Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc 2007/08, Domaine Vieux Télégraphe Rhône - France</b> Powerful yet elegant, packed with an abundance of spicy berry fruit. Classic style with real ageing potential. A great wine that is highly sought after.	<b>64.00</b>
11.	<b>Sancerre 'Culs de Beaujeu' 2007 - Francois Cotat Loire - France</b> Domaine Cotat is a shining example of old-school winemaking from one of the most prestigious names in Sancerre. Not much seems to have changed here in years, everything is done by the family on site. The result is outstanding Sancerre and there doesn't seem to be any need to change that.	<b>80.00</b>
12.	<b>Puligny-Montrachet Les Perrieres 1er Cru 2007 - Etienne Sauzet Burgundy - France</b> Grapes from ten small parcels of vines around the village go into this wine giving it great balance and complexity. It is also minerally, racy and long. Etienne Sauzet is one of the top three addresses in Puligny-Montrachet.	<b>140.00</b>
13.	<b>Corton Blanc Grand Cru 2002 - Domaine Chandon de Briailles Burgundy - France</b> One of the great family domaines of the Côte d'Or, with excellent holdings in Savigny itself and in neighbouring Pernand and on the hill of Corton. Energetic aromas of chalk, stone, fennel and white peach. Rich and smoothly textured mouthfeel is layered with tangy acidity and a firm core of concentration.	<b>200.00</b>

- 21. Gigondas 2005, Domaine Les Pallieres, Rhône - France** **44.00**  
This domaine is owned by the Brunier family who produce an earthy, smoky rich wine full of ripe cherry fruit. I discovered this wine whilst staying at my villa in the South of France. It works extremely well when matching with dishes similar in style, such as a robust and rustic beef or lamb dish.
- 22. Barolo 2006, Manfredi, Piedmont - Italy** **49.00**  
Red brick in colour, figs and truffles in evidence on the palate.
- 23. Santenay 'Vignes Vieilles' 2006/08, Domaine Paul Pillot Chassagne-Montrachet, Burgundy - France** **50.00**  
Intense with ruby hints, perfect blending between red fruits and oakiness. Full, spicy, fresh and elegant particularly persistent.
- 24. Gevrey-Chambertin 2006 -Serefin Pere et Fils, Burgundy** **90.00**  
The vines, from three separate vineyards, are 55 to 80 years-old, which explains the extraordinary density of fruit in this wine. Terrifically perfumed from the start, this is a finely tuned, elegant yet certainly powerful Gevrey.
- 25. Côte-Rôtie Côte Blonde 2003 - R. Rostaing, Rhône** **150.00**  
René Rostaing crafts some of the finest Côte-Rôties on the market today. Supersilky and refined, with layer upon layer of ripe red and dark berry fruit with long, finely grained tannins letting the additional anise, lavender and white pepper notes stretch out. Beautiful balance and elegance, with ample but refined structure as well.
- 26. Château Léoville Las Cases 1999 - St-Julien, Bordeaux** **210.00**  
Léoville Las Cases is also one of the largest, oldest and most picturesque of the Médoc's classified Bordeaux growths. The 1999 Leoville las Cases possesses a dense purple colour as well as classic aromas of vanilla, black cherries, and currants mixed with subtle toasty oak. Medium to full-bodied, with low acidity, it is forward, precocious, and already delicious.
